In getting your child ready for camp, a key element to ensure his safety and welfare, lies in the dispensing of regularly prescribed medication.

This season, as in years past, Camp Wigwam will team with **CampMeds**, should your child require scheduled medication while at camp.

As good health and safety are always our number one priorities at camp, the mandatory use of CampMeds is a policy that must be enforced, by the camp and by our families

What CampMeds accomplishes:

- 1.) It ensures that every camper get the correct medication and dosage, at the proper time and on the right day.
- 2.) The risk of medication distribution error is greatly reduced.
- 3.) The multi-dose packaging system of **CampMeds** allows several pills to be packaged together if they need to be given at the same time to a specific individual.
- 4.) Provides a sanitary environment for dispensing.

Medication administration time is reduced allowing campers to return to activities more quickly.
Small, portable packaging is ideal for day or overnight trips.
